

Memorandum of Agreement
between
Coast Guard Auxiliary National Board, Inc.
and
Lighthouse Uniform Company

Coast Guard Auxiliary National Board, Inc. (NBI), a District of Columbia Corporation, exists to provide private financial, logistical, and administrative and management support to the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary (The Auxiliary).

Lighthouse Uniform Company, (Lighthouse), a Washington corporation, is in business to produce and sell uniforms, insignia and related services, merchandise, etc. to units and members of various organizations including the United States Coast Guard (USCG) and The Auxiliary.

NBI and Lighthouse desire to enter into a mutually beneficial agreement to facilitate the timely acquisition by and supply at competitive prices of very good quality uniform clothing which meets or exceeds USCG /Auxiliary specifications for Auxiliary uniforms and related articles and services to the members of The Auxiliary.

Now, therefore, the parties to this agreement, in consideration of the mutual covenants and stipulations set forth herein, agree as follows:

Lighthouse agrees:

1. To identify, produce or acquire, stock, promote and sell as "Official Auxiliary" uniform items and related insignia and services only those items which are approved by or receive, upon request, the formal written approval of the USCG Uniform Board, USCG/Auxiliary regulations and standards pertaining to and controlling Auxiliary uniforms, insignia and services related thereto.
2. To sell direct to members of The Auxiliary on payment and delivery terms agreeable to buyer and seller.
3. To price the Lighthouse "Signature" line of premium Auxiliary uniform articles for sale directly to Auxiliary members at or below the prices established for essentially the same article available for purchase by members through the Coast Guard Exchange System (CGES) stores.
4. To sell Auxiliary uniform articles to NBI's Auxiliary Center on the same basis and at or below prices and on terms the same as similar items are sold to CGES.
5. To support NBI directly and The Auxiliary indirectly by the purchase of a display advertisement of at least one half page size in each and every issue of the NBI Beacon at the prevailing published rates available to all advertisers.
6. To display at the National Conference of The Auxiliary (NACON) purchasing a booth at the prevailing prices available to all purchasers of display booths.
7. To refer Auxiliary members inquiries regarding Auxiliary insignia to Auxiliary District Materials Officers in the member's Auxiliary district or region of residence.
8. To endeavor to provide semi-customized women's Auxiliary uniforms at prices consistent with the value of such uniforms given the amount of customization involved.

NBI – Lighthouse MOA (continued)

NBI agrees

1. To designate and recognize Lighthouse as an “Authorized Supplier” to members of the U. S. Coast Guard Auxiliary. Lighthouse may not be the only “Authorized Supplier” for the commodities it provides and NBI is not so constrained.
2. To permit linkage of the Lighthouse Internet web site homepage to the NBI home page, provided Lighthouse meets or exceeds the technical and organizational standards of the NBI web page and servers as NBI shall in its sole discretion determine.

Term of the Agreement:

1. This agreement shall remain in effect for a period of two years from the date of last party signature and may be renewed for successive two-year periods thereafter.
2. This agreement may be terminated by either part by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the other party and such termination shall be effective thirty (30) days from receipt of the written notice.

2. Either party may change the person and/or place concerning notice by notifying the other in the manner for giving notice.

Entire Agreement:

1. This agreement contains the entire agreement between Lighthouse and NBI and no statements, promises, or inducements made by either party or agent not contained in this agreement. Shall be valid or binding; this agreement may not be enlarged, modified or altered except in writing, signed by both parties and annexed to this agreement.
